Background Information:

- A. The curriculum cycle was suspended in 2009-2010 due to State Financial Plan and resumed in 2013-2014.
- B. The Illinois Textbook Loan Program (ITLP) which has supported textbook adoptions in the past is no longer available from ISBE.
- C. The Common Core State Standards adoption schedule for Illinois contributed to cycle decisions.
- D. During the years between complete reviews, curricula will be evaluated and revised as recommended by the instructional team.
- E. For budget planning purposes, the review of curriculum in a given year will result in the recommendation to adopt and purchase new textbooks/instructional materials and/or web licenses in the spring of that budget year. Curriculum materials will then be implemented in the following school year. A typical K-8 textbook/material adoption will cost up to \$300,000 (higher for Reading, with recurring costs for consumable materials).
- F. Professional development related to each content area review will also be included in each year's fiscal budget.
