POLICIES TO REVIEW/REVISE

7:20 Harassment of Students Prohibited - *STRIKE "Dean of Students" in two places and REPLACE with "Assistant Principal." STRIKE sentence "At least one of these individuals will be female, and at least one will be male." Our attorney has confirmed that this is NOT a requirement.*

7:270 Administering Medicines to Students
7:285 Food Allergy Management Program

*Both of these policies contain language about **School District Supply of Epinephrine Auto-Injectors**. I think the Policy Committee should discuss whether they want to include this topic in both policies. I recommend that it be contained **only** in Policy 7:270. The language in 7:270 is current and includes language about undesignated opioid antagonists. So, all language related to medication will be in one policy.*

If the Policy Committee agrees, the six paragraphs under the sub-heading "School District Supply of Epinephrine Auto-Injectors" in Policy 7:285 should be deleted (i.e., from "The district schools are hereby authorized..." through "Nothing in this policy shall prohibit any school employee from providing emergency assistance to students, including administering medication."

The language from "The Superintendent or designee shall develop and implement a Food Allergy Management Program that..1, 2, 3" MUST remain in Policy 7:285.
