RE: e-Learning Report

Background: During the 2022-2023 school year, District 113A will continue to implement the e-Learning day in the event an emergency day is implemented. While no one can plan whether or not we will have any school closings in the new school year, the district is preparing to run an educational day in the event of a school closing this year. The law that took effect July 1, 2019, reinstates the requirement that a school day consists of a minimum of five hours of instructional time. Public Act 101-0012 also allows school districts statewide to utilize e-Learning days in lieu of emergency days and maintains flexibility for students to engage in career-connected learning outside of the classroom.

According to Public Act, 101-0012 of 101st Illinois General Assembly, local school district e-Learning programs must be adopted by Board resolution and the local ROE must approve the program prior to the use of an emergency day. Before the adoption, the school board must hold a public hearing from the initial proposal or renewal of the e-Learning program.
