In an effort to ensure the health and well-being of students, faculty, and staff, and their families, Lemont Bromberek School District 113A will be closed and utilizing an e-Learning Day 1 on **Friday, March 13th**.

**It is important to note Lemont-Bromberek School District 113A administrators are not aware of any students, faculty or staff - or their family members - who have been diagnosed with COVID-19. We will communicate with our stakeholders if we are made aware of a positive diagnosis of COVID-19 within our school community.**

This decision was made in consultation with Lemont High School and the District 113A School Board and has been made with an abundance of caution because we serve the same students as LHS. As a result, we are taking the same precautionary measure to close the buildings for another “deep cleaning” on Friday, March 13, and over the weekend. If we are made aware of a positive diagnosis of COVID-19 within our school community, we would communicate with our stakeholders.

As you know, SD113A has an approved e-Learning plan and the district will use this opportunity to test the e-Learning Day 1 plan, which can be found at <https://www.sd113a.org/academics/e-learning>.

Please note that teachers may be updating the links before e-learning begins at 8:30 a.m. At that time, families will receive communication regarding e-Learning via e-mail. Families will be provided the opportunity to give the district feedback on the implementation of e-Learning Day1 via a survey link to be sent at the end of the day.

The district continues to monitor information from the state and federal health departments regarding the COVID-19 virus. Therefore, in an effort to keep our students, staff, and families safe, **we will be postponing the following large evening events scheduled through the start of Spring Break:**

- EL Family Game Night
- Field Trips (2nd Grade to Rialto Theatre)

For now, all after school clubs and practice groups will continue to meet until further notice. Athletes competing in games and matches will be notified regarding any upcoming cancellations.

**Champions will remain open for families from 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 13th. Drop off care is available for all students in District 113A and paperwork can be completed on-site with Champions staff upon entrance at Door 24 at RV. Champions staff will support students with their e-Learning Day 1 plans.**

While we expect school to be in session on Monday, March 16, we will communicate with you no later than 7 p.m. on Sunday, March 15, if that were to change. School administrators continue to monitor information and guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH). In the event the building needs to be closed for an extended period of time, we will continue to communicate e-Learning plans with our families.
